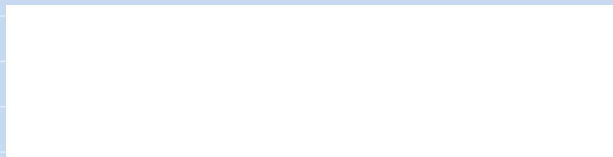
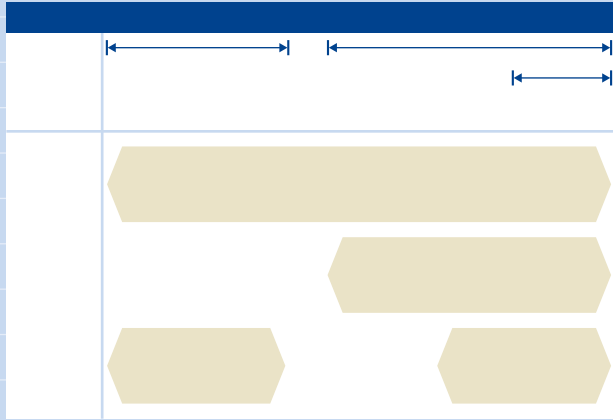
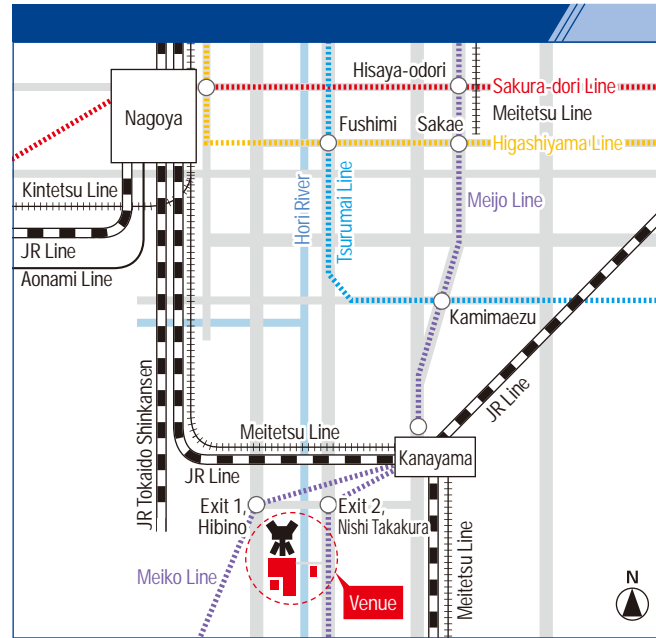

In October 2010, Aichi-Nagoya will host the 10th Conference of the Parties to the Convention on Biological Diversity (COP 10).

Over 7,000 people from more than 190 countries and regions will meet at COP 10, the world's leading environmental conference, to find ways to preserve biodiversity and other environmental resources.

The United Nations has declared 2010 as the International Year of Biodiversity. It is also the last year for achieving the 2010 Biodiversity Target, which is a global target for a significant reduction of the rate of biodiversity loss to be achieved by 2010.

COP 10 presents an opportunity for assessing progress toward achievement of the target and for discussing the adoption of a new target.

COP 10 therefore represents a major milestone in addressing the Convention on Biological Diversity.

The Interactive Fair for Biodiversity, an international exhibition to be held concurrently with COP 10, represents an opportunity for presentations and interaction under the theme of biodiversity.

The venue will be the Shirotori area adjacent to the COP 10 venue.

There, national and local governments, international organizations, NGOs, NPOs, academic institutions, private enterprises, and many other exhibitors from around the world will present projects, initiatives, ideas, and issues at their display booths, all in the interests of preserving biodiversity.

At the same time, stage performances, forums, and other events will be held to encourage participants to enjoy exploring and learning about biodiversity.
